

## GENERAL ROUTE DESCRIPTION

This is a linear route of approximately 2.9 km (1.8 miles) when including the return journey. The bridleway is tarmac from the car park at Horncastle and then changes to compacted stone (there are some loose stones throughout the route) as it leaves the outskirts of Horncastle.

The route only uses part of the Spa Trail. The trail continues on to the outskirts of Woodhall Spa (a total of 3 miles) and is surfaced with compacted stone along the whole length.

The route is over 1m wide for all its length. For detailed information about the slopes and surfaces and to see if the path is suitable for you, please see the map inside the leaflet.
